Spinning tops have been made from carved bone and painted wood.

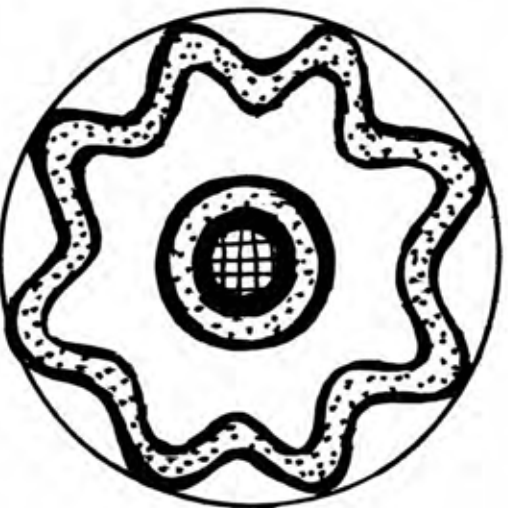

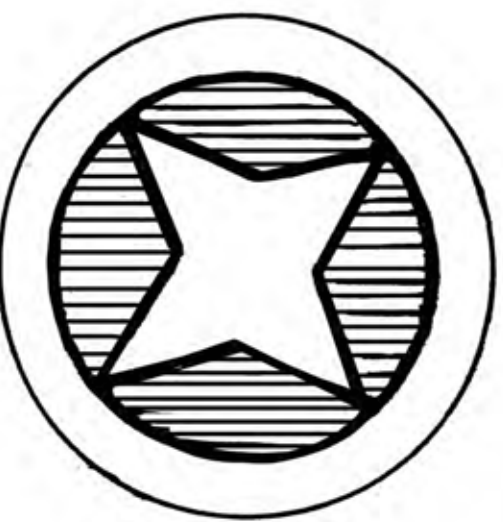

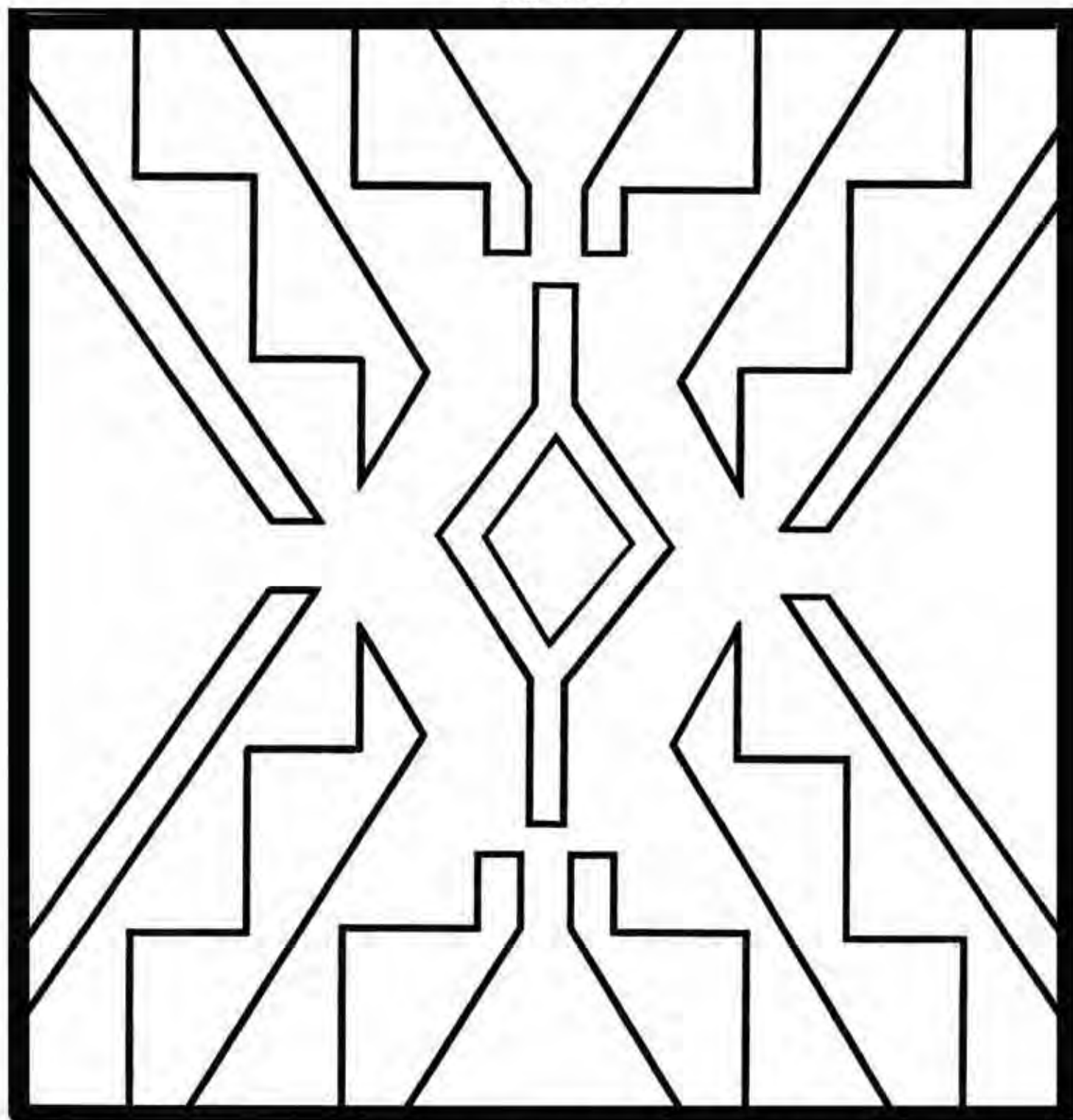
