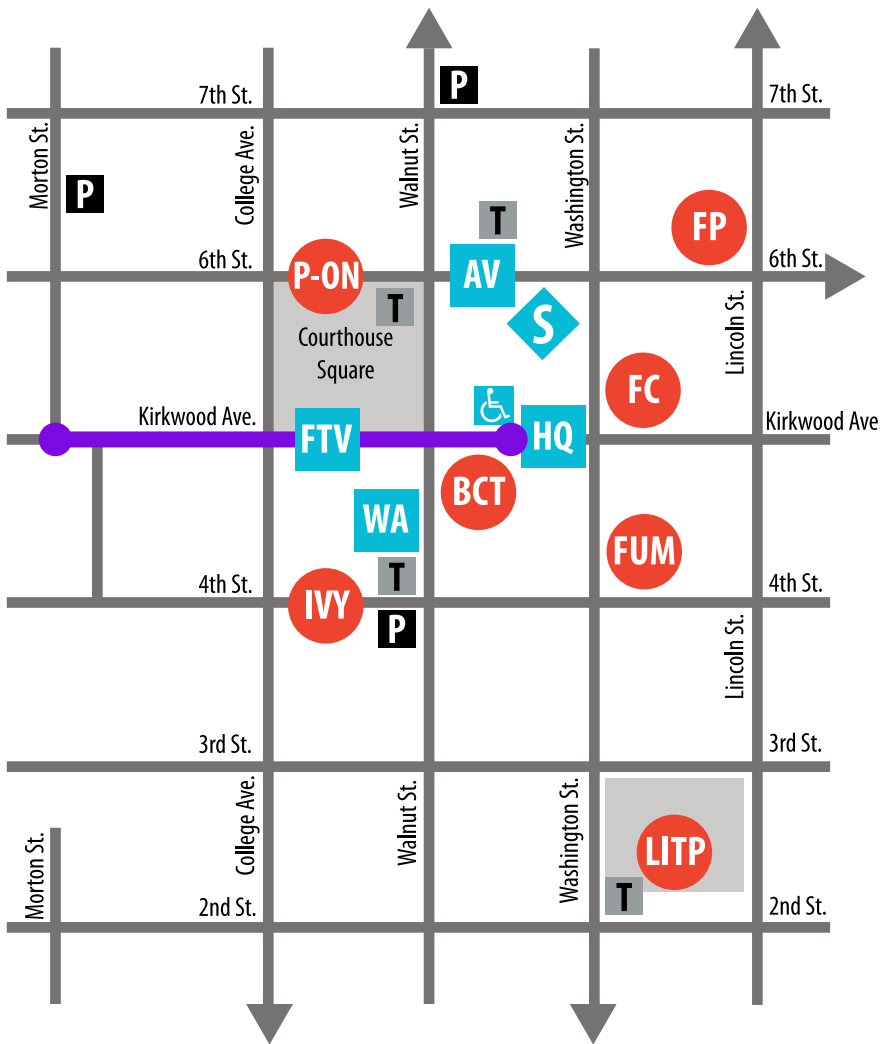


The Lotus Education and Arts Foundation is committed to providing arts programs that are accessible to audiences of all ages and abilities.
