

Lotus Education & Arts Foundation Sound Tech Internship



Learn how to set up and run sound for artists performing for Lotus Blossoms. For this internship, you will accompany a Lotus staff member (or have your own vehicle) to travel to various venues to unload the Lotus sound system and set it up for artists doing performances in area schools and other community sites. You will arrive at the site one hour before the show. Set up takes approximately half an hour, followed by a brief sound check. If willing and able, you will learn to run sound during the show. Post-show, you will break down the system, learning to wrap cords and stow equipment.

Time commitment varies, but ideally you commit to a full day (8:00am to 4:00pm) – for a 10am show and a 2pm show, allowing for travel time to each location.

You do not have to be available for all of these dates, but you should be available for at least one of them, as these are the dates on which there will be programming.

Lotus internships are unpaid but may qualify for university credit; options vary by department. Please consult with Lotus staff and faculty advisors to determine credit eligibility.
